Clinical Counsellor/ Social Worker

Northumberland Community Counselling Centre (NCCC) is a family service agency providing a wide range of clinical and community based services that are accessible and responsive for all ages throughout Northumberland County to enhance personal, family and community functioning and well being.

NCCC is seeking experienced applicants to fill a contract position in the Family Violence Program and a contract position in the Community Counselling Program. These positions can be blended to provide full time employment or remain part-time.

Responsibilities:

In the "Family Violence Program", you will provide specialized individual counselling, group counselling and support services to women and children who have experienced abuse in their family and/or intimate partner relationships. This includes intake/risk assessment, safety planning, outreach, strengths-based counselling (individual and group), case management, community development and advocacy.

In the "Community Counselling Program" you will provide assessment and clinical intervention for individuals, couples, families and groups of all ages with diverse backgrounds and varied clinical presentations.

Qualifications Required:

- B.S.W. with three years related experience or M.S.W. with at least one year of relevant experience;
- Registration with O.C.S.W.S.S.W., or equivalent professional designation and registration;
- Committed to feminist and anti-oppression/ anti-racism principles and have a thorough understanding of the social, economic and political context of woman and child abuse;
- Strong knowledge and skills in clinical assessment and intervention to address the impact on women and children of trauma related to violence including grief, mental health and substance issues;
- Demonstrated expertise for individual, couple, family intervention including brief models, therapeutic and psycho-educational group work skills;
- Specific clinical expertise in areas of mental health, addictions, poverty, blended family, grief and trauma is an asset;
- Possess a valid driver's license, access to a vehicle and the ability to travel;
- Ability to work flexible hours according to program requirements; and
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Screening.
